Fantini Pinot Grigio, Sicily, Italy 27.5
175ml glass 8

Dazzling with enticing fruit and fresh herb aromas, a scintillating mouthful of rich peach and grapefruit is evident on the palate. Lemon, lime and a mineral crispness also persist with a gentle spicy finish.

Pierre Lamotte Chardonnay, France 27.5
175ml glass 8

Generous and seductive with notes of nectarine and acacia. Elegant, round and well-balanced with flavours of exotic fruits and a long finale.

Fernlands Sauvignon Blanc, NZ 27.5
175ml glass 8

Highly aromatic, the nose shows unmistakable tropical aromas of guava and gooseberry with a slight hint of Granny Smith apple.

Picpoul de Pinet, Languedoc, France 30

The gloriously fruity, perfumed, light-bodied Picpoul de Pinet reveals copious notes of honeyed citrus (grapefruit and lemon zest), good acidity, and delicate honeyed pear-like flavours.

Russbach Riesling, Germany 31

This is an off dry style, so neither sweet or dry, but has obvious hints of sweetness, which is great against the backdrop of piercing acidity that the German Rieslings are renowned for. Expect lots candied lime flavours, fruit salad and floral notes, while the palate is crisp, fresh and lingers deliciously.

Pasas Viura SB, Yecla, Spain (Vg)

32

The flavours will delight your senses. There is notes of pineapple and banana, citrics and vanilla, in an harmonious concentration of natural sweetness, and optimal acidity.

Paul Jaboulet Viognier, Rhone, France

32.5

Its nose is very expressive with aromas of white fruits, peach, accompanied by notes of flowers, a typical Viognier complexity.

Garzon Reserve Albariño, Maldonado, Uruguay

39.5

This Albariño wine from Garzón will be the icon of Uruguayan wines, portraying ripe aromas of white peaches, citrus fruits like grapefruit and featuring floral notes of jasmine.

Pascal Bouchard Petit Chablis (Organic), France

45

The nose expresses aromas of fruit. Discrete, well-integrated oak lends vanilla and toasted notes that give way to a mineral finish. Starts off bold, round, and rich on the palate with good body, structure, and length.

rosé

Elicio Rosé, Due Arbie, France

28

Bright pink colour and nose packed with fresh raspberry and heady flowers lead to a juicy palate that echoes the aromas revealed by the vibrant nose, then throws in tropical and mineral notes.

De Ladoucette Sancerre Comte Lafond, Fra

75

A stunning white wine with a rich and complex bouquet. This wine is made from Sauvignon Blanc grapes grown in the Comte Lafond vineyard situated on the slopes of Sancerre. The aroma displays notes of ripe citrus, stone fruits and a hint of minerality.

De Ladoucette Pouilly Fumé, Loire France

80

Nicely balanced with a subtle floral and earthy fern nose; Notes of stony minerals and lemon provide delights to the palate. Its velvety finish has hints of citrus fruits.

La Crema Saralee's Vineyard Chardonnay,
Russian River, USA

90

This white from the great vineyard site is intense in approach and full-bodied richness. Thick, concentrated layers of tropical and stone fruit effuse from the palate adorned in toasted oak and lasting lushness.

Chartron & Trebuchet Meursault, Burgundy

95

This Meursault is a generous wine, open and expressive, with fleshy white fruit, honey and nuts. There is intensity on the palate, and a lovely citrus freshness.

Domaine Regnard Grande Chablis, Fra

95

Pale yellow in colour, aromas of white flowers, lemon and grapefruit zest with pronounced chalky notes. The palate is clean, flavours of white peach, green apple and lemon zest before the complex chalky minerality form the nose emerges.

reds

- Elicio Red (Grenache/Merlot), France** 28
175ml glass 8
Earthy, juicy, luscious fruit. A bold mouthfeel coats the entire palate and a low acid leaves balanced tannins to slowly melt away
- Heartland Stickleback Shiraz, Langhorne, Aus** 27
175ml glass 8
Bright red in colour with fresh aromas of blackcurrant, dark fruits and herbal spice. Mouth filling flavours of plum and chocolate intermingle with subtle oak and smooth tannins.
- Anubis Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina** 27.5
175ml glass 8
From the Argentinian wine-growing region Mendoza is a grape variety pure, velvety and soft red wine. In the glass this wine shines in a rich ruby red with cherry red highlights. A typical aroma of ripe raspberries and black currants caresses the nose.
- Fantini Montepulciano, Sicily, Italy** 27.5
The Montepulciano d'Abruzzo is a juicy, mouth filling red loaded with dark fruit supported by a streak of minerality that provides focus and length.
- Esprit Barville Cotes du Rhone Rouge, France** 31
Smooth, warming and elegant. Its aromas recall wild red fruits, dark cherries, forest floor and liquorice. The tannins are soft yet precise.
- Santa Alicia Gran Reserva Cab Sauv, Chile** 31
Aromas of prunes, chocolate, some notes of Menthol characteristic from the Valley and toasted oak are also obvious. The palate is well structured with firm tannins.

Gran Pasas Monastrell, Yecla, Spain 33
Deep dark ruby red colour with violet blue rim. The aromas are mature blackberries, ripe juicy dark cherries gentle.

Le Vaux St. Georges Pinot Noir, Loire 33
Aromas are of ripe, almost sweet berry fruit and floral notes. Juicy strawberry flavours, refreshing acidity and the gentlest of tannins come together in this great value cool-climate Pinot Noir.

Batasiolo Langhe Nebbiolo, Italy 43
A wine of intense ruby red colour, more or less, and with garnet according to aging. The nose shows intense and delicate aromas of ripe fruit that evolve into spicy notes with subtle floral nuances. The palate is full-bodied, tannic and pleasantly cool.

Susana Balbo Signature Malbec, Mendoza, Arg 52.5
Made with purchased grapes from Altamira, this impressive, limestone-influenced Malbec contains 6% Petit Verdot. It's a scented, well-balanced expression of the grape with bright acidity, crunchy blackberry fruit, well integrated oak and filigree tannins.

Muga Reserva Rioja, Spain 56
A masterclass in oak ageing, spending 36 months in oak before further resting in the bottle. The oak gives it a fantastic structure. Combined with supple, ripe tannins, it'll easily last for a decade – but it's delicious now. Its flavours are richly complex. Think blackberry, vanilla, coffee, and a hint of spice.

- Coste Arente Amarone della Valpolicella, Veneto** 60
A complex bouquet of red and black fruit along with spicy notes of liquorice tobacco and black pepper.
- Jaboulet Chateauneuf du Pape Les Cedres, Rhone** 95
Deep ruby red colour with very thick legs. The bouquet offers complex and intense notes of macerated red berries, blended with sweet spices and a final hint of garrigue (Mediterranean vegetation). Powerful and warm attack in the mouth, with a spicy and hot finish.
- La Crema Russian River Pinot Noir, California** 100
Aromas of black cherry, blackberry jam, and cedar are followed by flavours of strawberry, boysenberry, and saffras. This vintage presents balanced acidity and plush tannins.
- Batasiolo Barolo DOC, Italy** 128
The colour is deep garnet red. The bouquet has all the typical aromas of the grape nebbiolo after the aging period provided by the process of production, showing the dried fruit, flowers, spices, sweets, and the typical delicate herbaceous aromas. In the mouth, the perfect balance between tannins, freshness and the alcoholic content, offer truly powerful sensations but absolutely elegant and pleasing.

- Silterra Prosecco, Italy** 27
Glass 8
Acacia, peach, and pear flower aromas burst from the glass as the fine bubbles in this Prosecco burst.
- Nozecco, Fra (Vg)** 12
The perfect drink made from alcohol-removed wine, natural grape profile with fine & elegant bubbles.
- Tenuta St. Anne Rosé Prosecco, Italy** 30
A dry, fruity, and elegant Italian Sparkling wine with an aromatic and berry aroma of rose blossoms and fresh red berries.
- Henri Champliau Crémant de Bourgogne Rosé, Fra** 42.5
A beautiful salmon pink colour, a delicate nose of white flowers and red berries, clear and intense on the palate. Pinot Noir is predominant in the blend, bringing elegance and strength, while the freshness of Chardonnay and the delicacy of the Gamay perfect the balance of this cuvée.
- Jacquinet & Fils, Fra** 80
The colour is of a nice gold with a hue of pink gold. The tiny bubbles are revealing the characteristic of this blend which is fruit characters of Cherry and Strawberry along with a nice freshness.
- Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label, Fra** 85
This cuvée is the result of a blending of grapes from as many as 50 to 60 different crus and is composed of up to 45% reserve wines. The Pinot Noir predominance provides its strength, while Chardonnay provides its freshness and a touch of Meunier its fruitiness.
- Bollinger Special Cuvée N.V., Champagne, Fra** 95
Special Cuvée has a beautiful aromatic complexity; ripe fruit and spicy aromas; hints of roasted apples, compote, and peaches. A subtle combination of structure, length and vivacity; bubbles like velvet; pear, brioche and spicy aromas, notes of fresh walnut.
- Dom Perignon 2013, Champagne, Fra** 350
The creation of the 2013 vintage reveals the resonance between the pinot's noirs and chardonnays, between acidity and full-bodied. The precise, elegant, and tactile bouquet blooms in an extremely delicate powdery aromatic braid around three nuances: first citrus, then a more vegetal facet and lastly, spices.

dessert wine, port

The Sticky End, Noble Sauvignon, Marlborough 38
50ml glass 9

Juicy nectarine and golden fleshed peach flavours meld seamlessly with the spicy citrus zest influence of the Noble Rot. Powerfully sweet and richly fruited yet ultimately balanced by a nervy thread of acidity that enlivens the long Sticky End.

Niepoort LBV, Portugal 5.5
50ml glass

Dark ruby in colour, dark chocolate aromas to the foreground, along with fruits of the forest, a spicy warming finish.

Niepoort 10-Year-Old Tawny, Portugal 7
50ml glass

Aromas of dried apricots, crystallized tangerine, lemon peel with hints of toffee, caramel, and honey.
